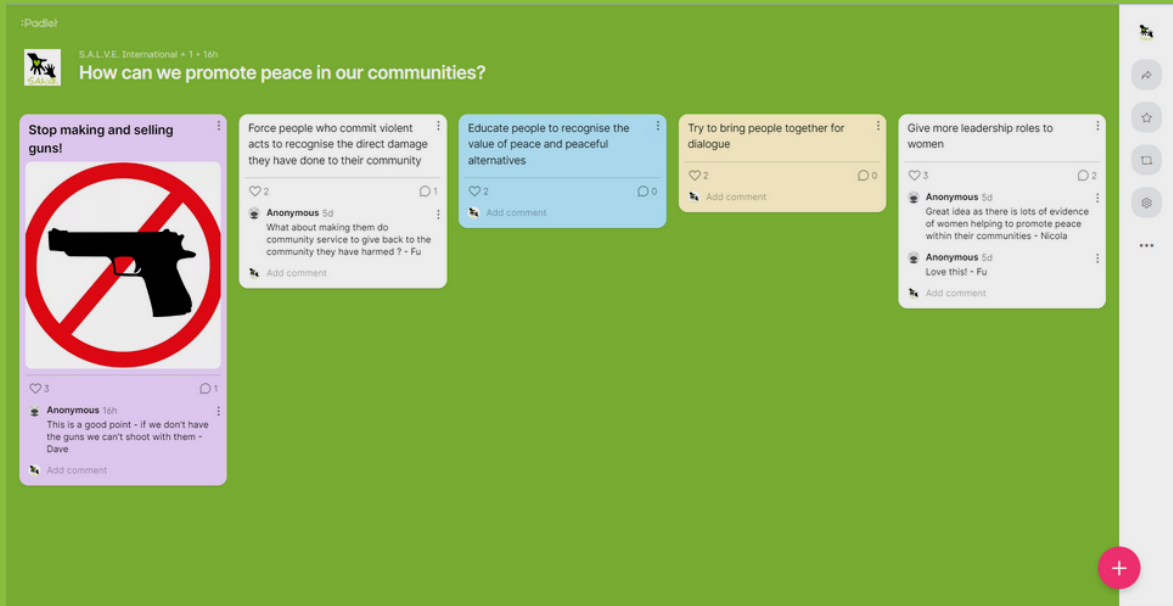


Padlet walkthrough guide for the Inequality Question

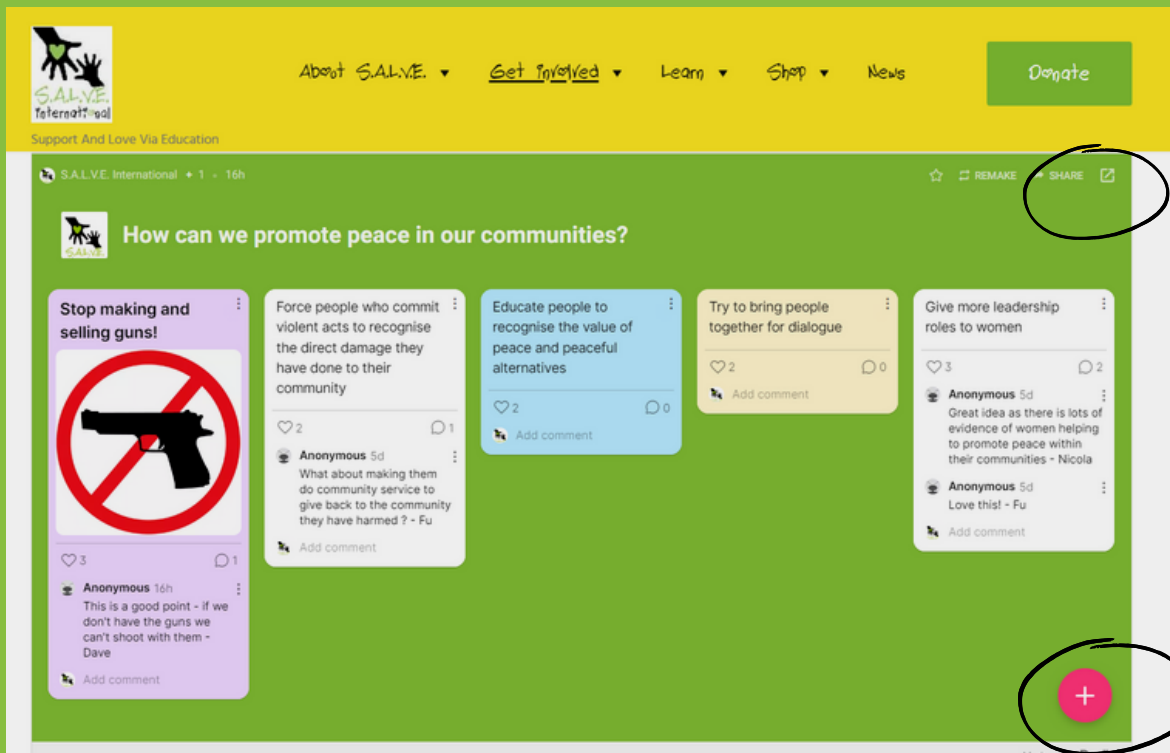


1. Open up the Padlet discussion.
It should look something like this.



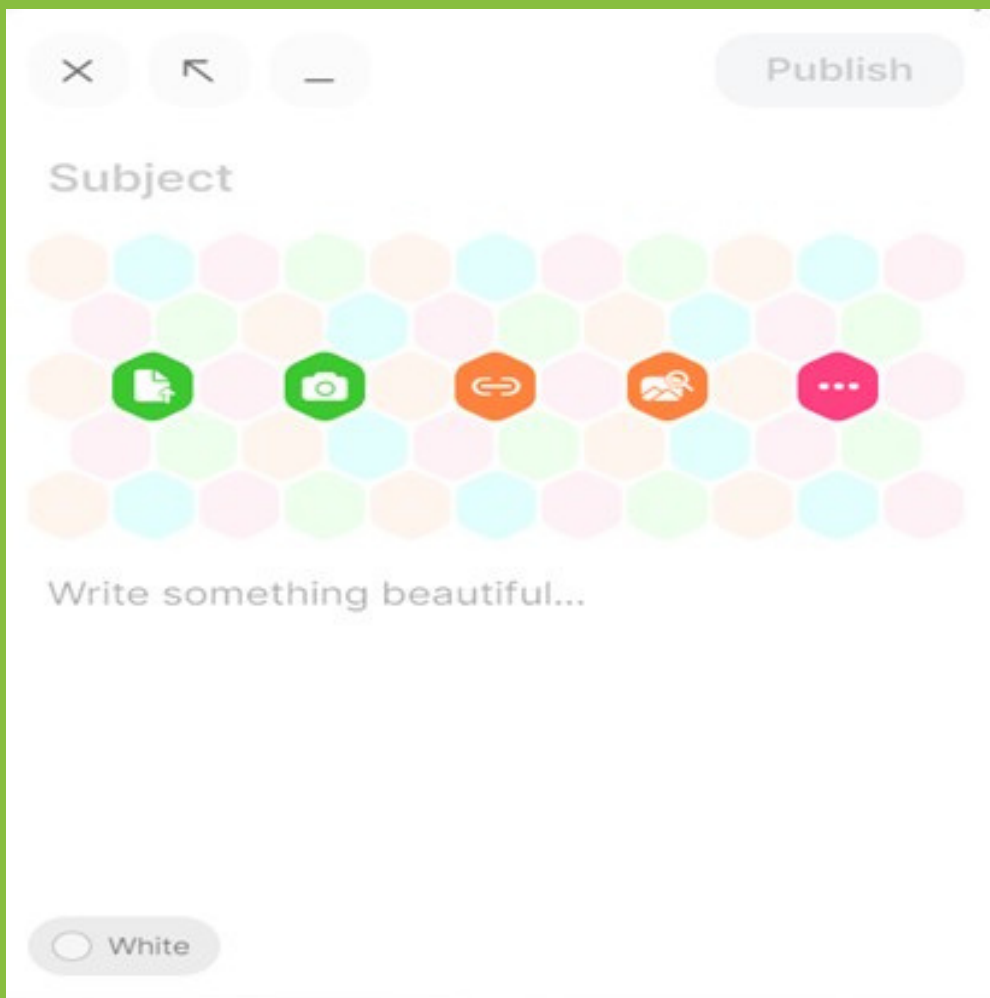
2. Opening Padlet from our website

You can also access the discussion from our website.
Click the pink '+' or click the arrow at the top right to open it.



3. Adding your comment

Click on the + to add your comment. Ideally add your comment on the box reading 'write something beautiful'. You don't have to add a subject/title.

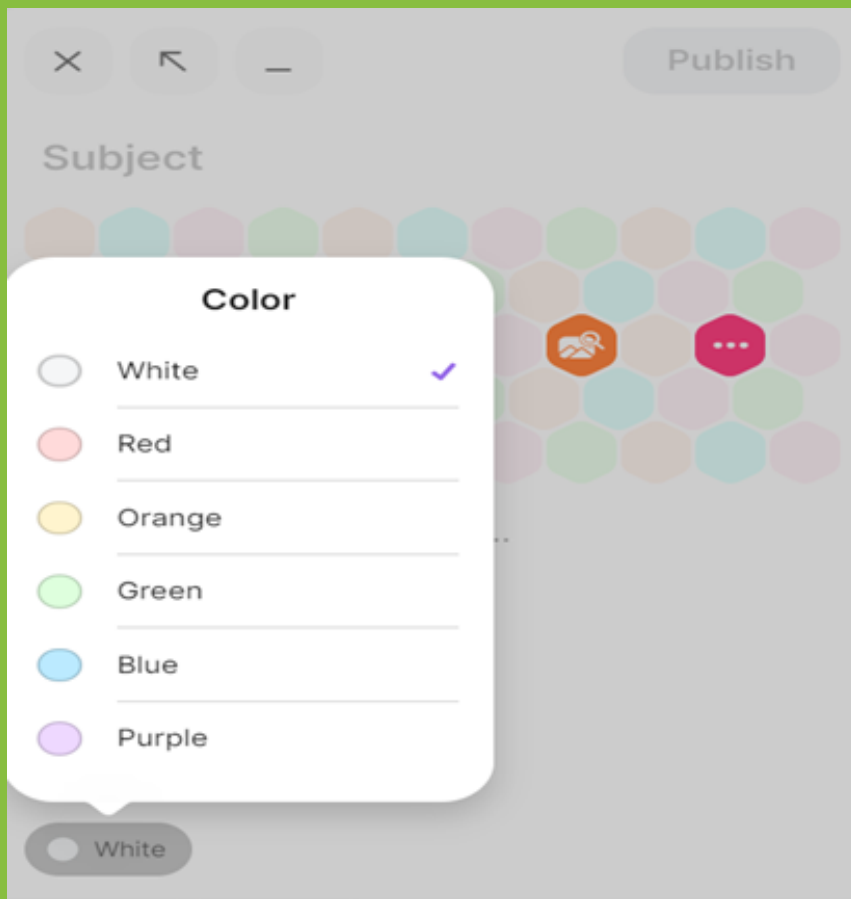


4. Customize your comment

You can even change the colour of the comment!

5. Posting your comment

Click 'Publish' to add your comment.



6. Reacting to what other people have said

If you like what someone else has said, just click the 'heart' below.

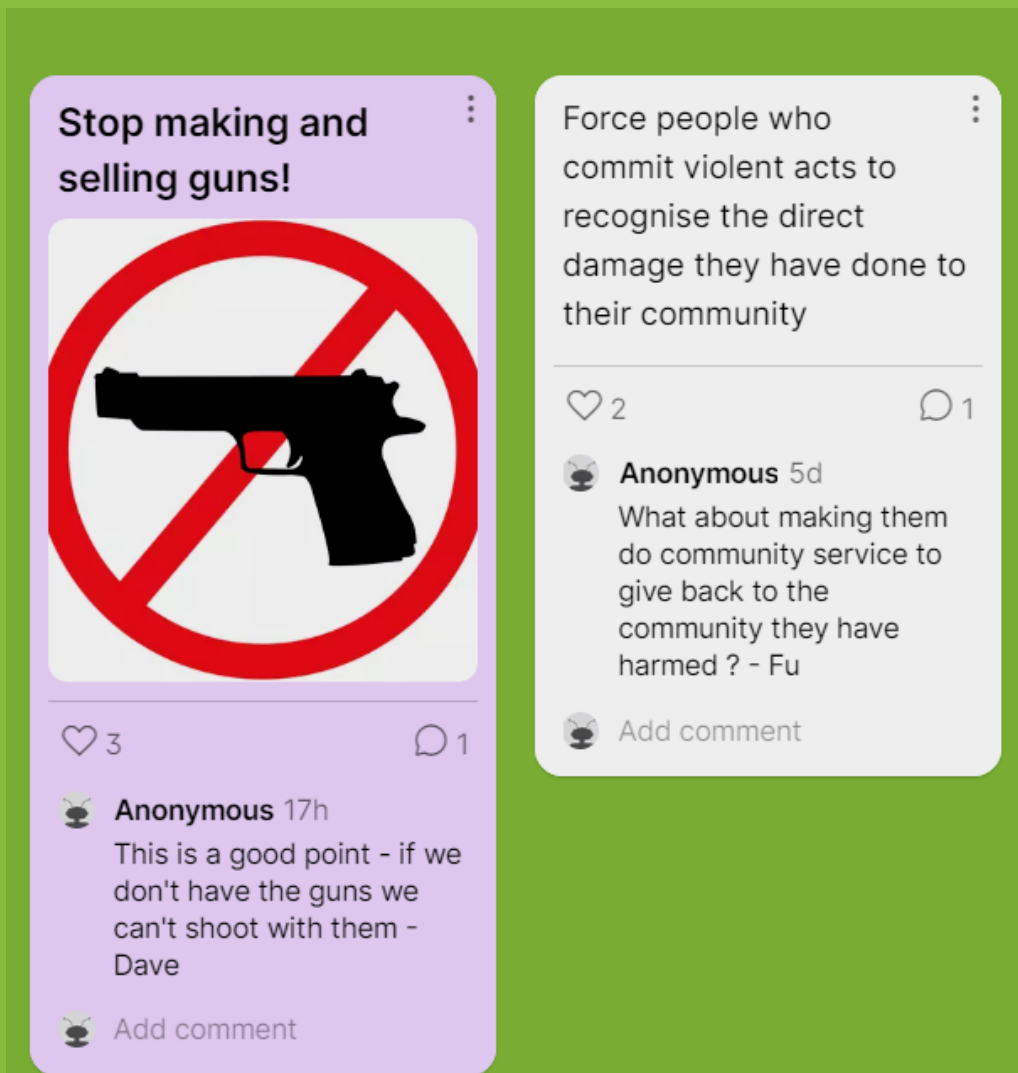
7. Adding comments to other people's posts

To add on to what someone else has already said, 'add comment'.

8. Make it personal

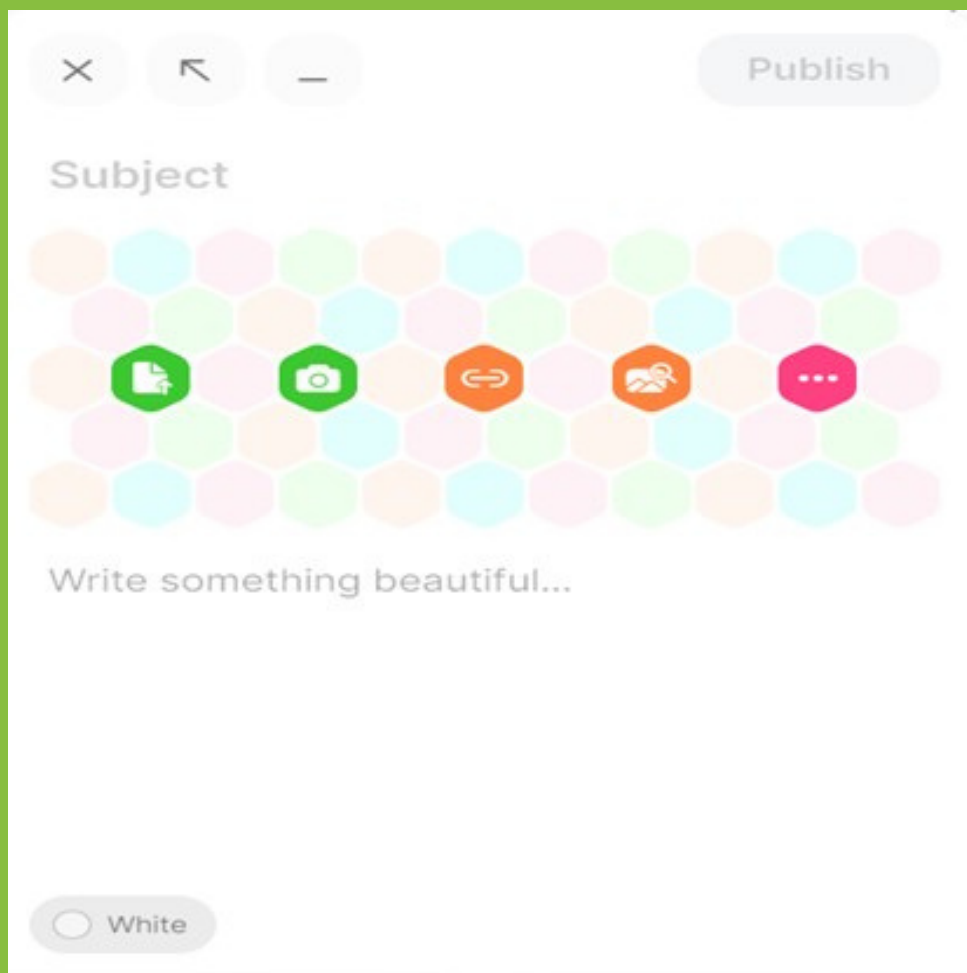
We'd love it if you would put your name at the end of your comment. This makes the discussion feel more personal and interactive! Just put '-your name' at the end! However, it's up to you if you want to share a name or not. Fake names are also allowed



9. Adding Images

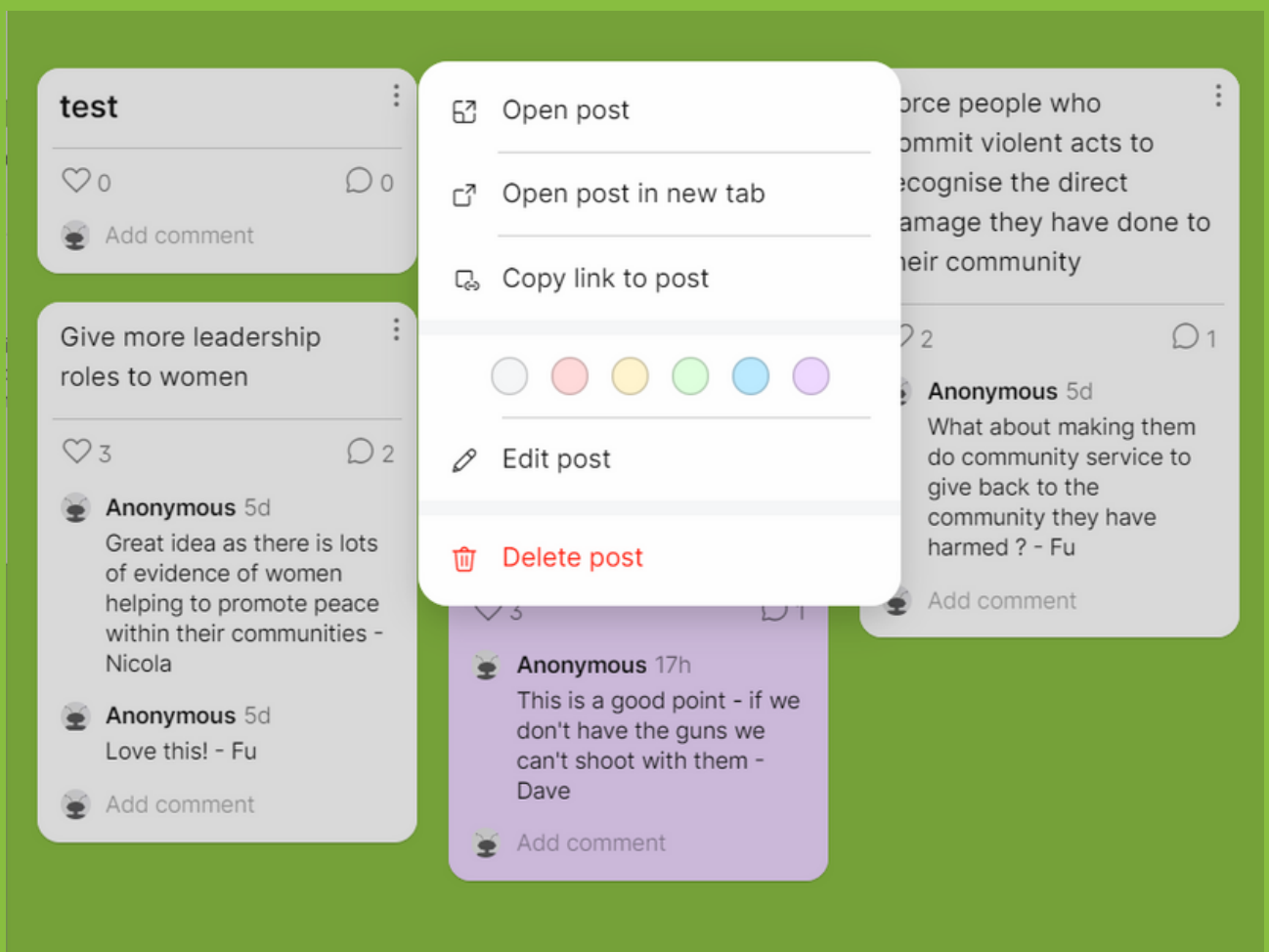
You can even add so much more to your answer.

If you want to add an image, you can either upload your own or use the image search function. If you're feeling really creative, clicking on the 3 dots allows you to pick the drawing function.



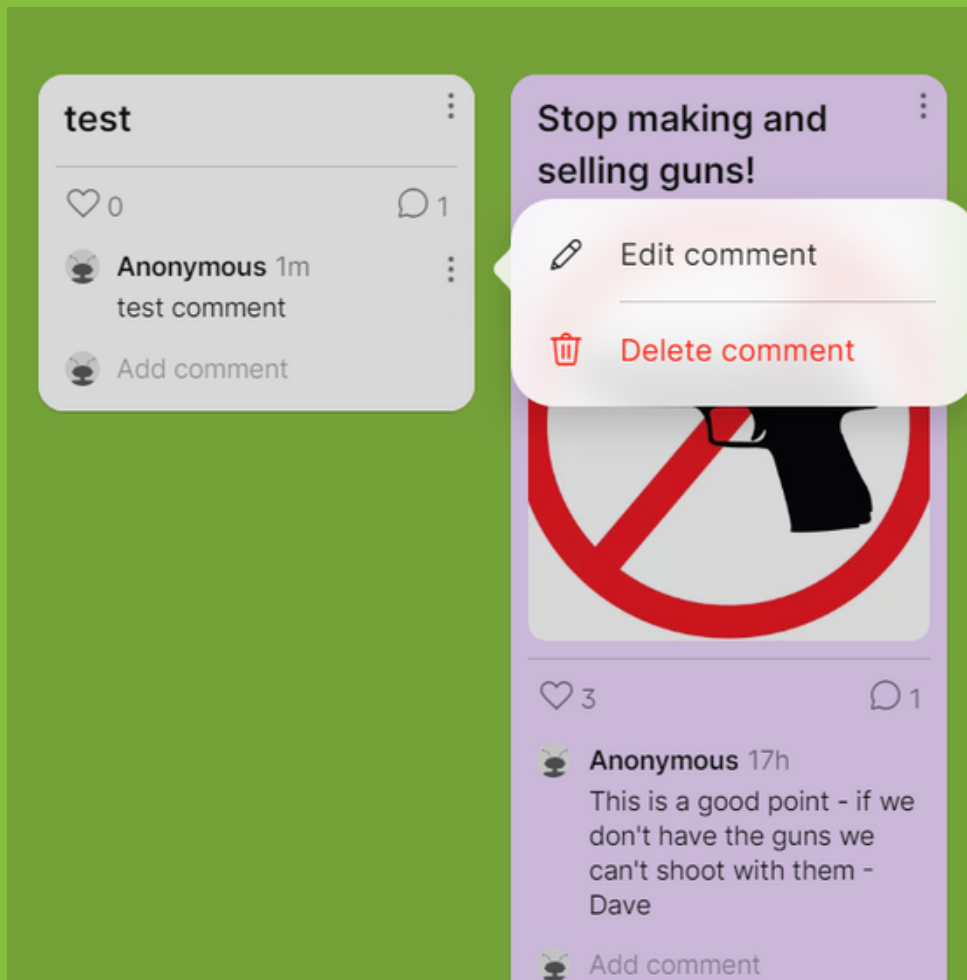
10. Editing or deleting posts

You can edit or delete your post by clicking on the 3 dots to the right hand side of your post.



//. Editing or deleting comments

Similarly, clicking to the side of your comment allows you to edit or delete it.
